

Punctuating titles notes: 11/27/2020

Underline and capitalize the important words in the following titles: book, movie, movie series, tv show, newspapers, magazine titles, musical album, and anything considered long/complete and self contained.

Note: when typing on a computer, just italicize these titles which is the same as underlining when writing it out by pencil.

Capitalize the important words and use "quotations" around the following titles: book chapters, tv episodes, any type of article, poem titles, song titles, and anything else that is part of a whole or larger work.

Note: Prepositions, articles, and conjunctions are not capitalized in titles unless they are either the first or last words of the titles.

Examples

I read an interesting article about kayaking in the magazine Sea Explorer.

I love the reality show called The Amazing Race.

Are we going to recite the poem we learned, "The Road Not Taken," at the next assembly?

The first chapter of the book is called "The Trail of the Meat".
